Advancedlife has advised us that our school photos will be delivered within 10 days. They have had a small production problem.

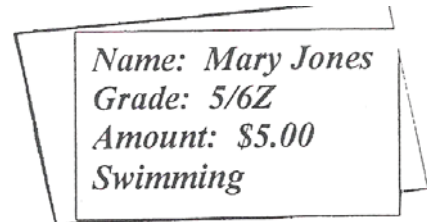
MONEY - REMINDER
